### 4. Activity coordinators updates/items for discussion

- Training: Working with climbing coordinators to book training with Charles Laliberté for winter training as needed.
- We are discussing the potential for National organising an Eastern mountennering event as most events tend to be in the West.
- Guidelines for gas Money: Grant has done extensive research, he has come up with a
